ORDINANCE NO. 682

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PENDER, NEBRASKA TO AMEND SECTION 3-603 OF THE VILLAGE CODE; TO UPDATE TRASH REMOVAL RATES AND DUMP ACCESS FEE PROVISIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF PENDER, NEBRASKA:

Section §3-603 of the Village code shall be amended to read as follows:

3-603 Municipal Solid Waste Removal and Landfill Rates.

SECTION 1. Except as set forth below, residential customers, excluding commercial customers, shall be charged a minimum fee of \$26.00, which represents a monthly charge of \$21.00 per residential customer per an agreement with S2 Roll-Offs, LLC, and a \$5.00 monthly fee representing administration costs and the use of the Pender Landfill for permitted residential refuse. Multi-family residences, apartments, or townhome customers who utilize the Village's refuse service shall be charged the same rate as all other residential customers. Multi-family residences, apartments, or townhome customers may opt-out of the Village's refuse service if there is an existing trash disposal contract servicing their facility with a commercial provider but a \$5.00 fee for access to the Pender Landfill for permitted residential use shall be assessed to said customers.

SECTION 2. Residential customers who have an existing trash can provided by the Village's trash disposal provider shall have the option of requesting an additional trash can. Customers who utilize this option shall be charged an additional \$8.00 per month.

SECTION 3. Should the Village Board vote to provide said services to a customer outside of the corporate limits and providing that the trash removal company agrees to provide the service, whether or not within the zoning jurisdiction of the Village, said service shall be provided at a rate 15% higher than the above-referenced rates for the service charge and usage.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication, or posting as required by law.

SECTION 5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this Ordinance and in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
