

ORDINANCE NO. 659

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VILLAGE ORDINANCE 6-313 TO CHANGE THE DATES FIREWORKS MAY BE SOLD FROM JUNE TWENTY FOURTH AND JULY FIFTH TO JUNE TWENTY-FOURTH THROUGH JULY FIFTH AND DECEMBER TWENTY EIGHTH AND JANUARY FIRST OF EACH YEAR FOR THE VILLAGE OF PENDER, THURSTON COUNTY, NEBRASKA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING A TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Section §6-313 of the municipal code of Pender, Nebraska, shall be amended to read as follows:

6-313 Misdemeanors; Firecrackers. It shall be unlawful for any person to ignite or cause to be exploded fireworks or firecrackers of any description whatsoever, except those considered to be permissible by law, and sold only between June twenty-fourth (24th) and July fifth (5th) and between December twenty-eighth (28th) and January first (1st) inclusive of any year. SECTION 2.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance, and in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as provided by law.
